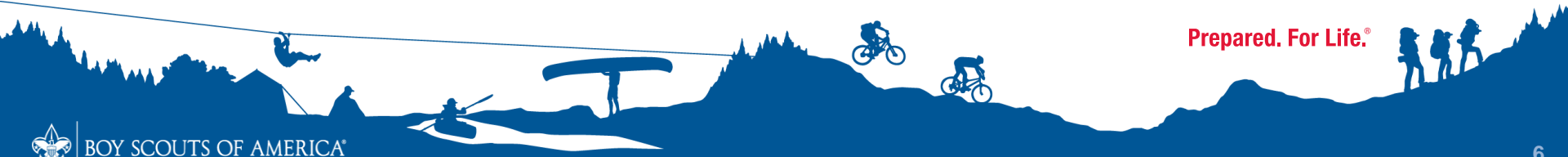

- **2022 Goal is 24,190.00 Unit FOS Goal is 14,190.00 and Community FOS Goal is 10,000.00**

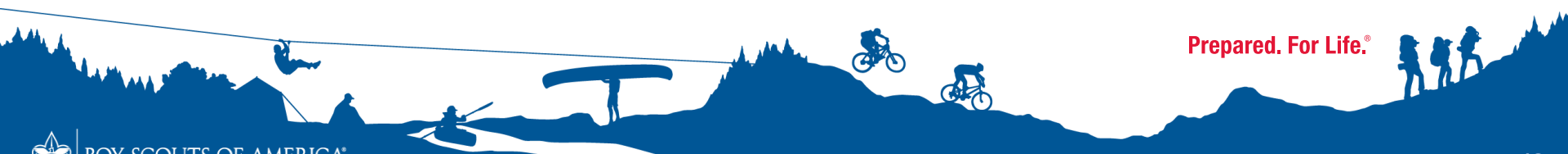
